Reporting of your Company's Business Output

The reporting functionality allows generating different kinds of reports:

- *Inventory – complete list of your network and locally attached output devices*
- *Workload statistics:*
 - Standard reports – predefined reports available to all users;*
 - Customized reports – reports that can completely be designed and customized by an individual user and made public to other users*

Client Workstation Auditing

All network-centric and local print jobs including volume and type (b/w or color, paper size, duplex and document type) that are generated from every client within your network are recorded centrally and can be displayed in either individually defined or predefined reports.

Cost Allocation

Print volumes and average cost per page (as preset by your administrator) can be individually assigned to cost centers, e.g. users, user groups or output devices.

Clear Cost Analysis

A clear cost analysis enables decision makers to get a comprehensive view of the current costs for all print jobs in a defined environment. With the JScribe® Intelligence Server Solution, the actual costs of print jobs can be determined and then allocated to cost centers, departments or other accounting groups in a flexible, user-defined way. While accounting is a desperately needed instrument to identify future saving potentials, it does not have immediate influence on the costs themselves. Therefore, the JScribe® Intelligence Server Solution comes with a set of features suitable to realize an immediate and significant savings potential through entirely automated and centralized functions.

Create Cost Awareness

Most users thoughtlessly print emails and documents for easy reading, sometimes unaware of the costs this causes and sometimes feeling safe in the knowledge that the costs caused cannot be determined and assigned on user level. Even worse, on department or enterprise level any cost control is missing since no comprehensive tools have been established for these functions.
